NPORS Cards Explained

NPORS Traditional Card

To gain this card you must:

- Pass a NPORS course.

This card lasts for 5 years and can be renewed by completing the relevant paperwork that needs to be signed by your supervisor or employer.

(You do not need to sit a Touchscreen Test. This card does not show the CSCS Logo.)



NPORS Trained Operator Card (Red)

To gain this card you must:

- pass the Health, Safety & Environment Touchscreen Test for Operatives.

This card is in date for 2 years and cannot be renewed, you will need to complete an NVQ in the Categories listed on the back of your card for it to be upgraded.

This card is more recognised on sites as it shows the CSCS Logo.



NPORS Competent Operator Card (Blue)

To gain this card you must:

- pass the Health, Safety & Environment Touchscreen Test for Operatives. (In date within 2 years)
- completed an NVQ in each Category shown on the reverse of your card.

This card lasts for 5 years and can be renewed.

This card is recognised on all sites and shows the CSCS Logo. (Some say it is the equivalent to a CPCS card.)

What is a CPCS Card?

Compared to various other trade card schemes, there are very few CPCS cards available. There are three in total, which basically function as beginner, intermediate, and advanced cards.

For a 12-month extension:

Hold a CPCS Red Trained Operator card which is in date, or within 12 months from the expiry date and Be registered for a VQ relevant to the category you will be asked to provide proof of a VQ registration This is a non-refundable fee for the services of processing the application.

A new card will be issued for 12 months (from the date of application) to enable the VQ to be achieved. Once the VQ has been achieved, you will be able to apply to Upgrade to a Blue Competent Operator card.

Different types of CPCS cards:

Trained operator card (Red)



1. Pass the necessary health and safety awareness test, as determined by the Construction Industry Training Board.
2. Pass the CPCS theory test within two years of Step 1.
3. Pass the CPCS practical test within six months of Step 2.

The trained operator card is only valid for two years and it is not technically renewable. However, since it is assumed that holders of this card will be working toward achieving their competent operator card, an extension is possible.

Upgrading a red CPCS card:

1. Hold a CPCS Red Trained Operator Card for the category which is within 12 months of expiry date if the extension has been applied for or 24 months if the extension has not been applied for
2. Pass the relevant CITB health, safety, and environment test within the last two years.
3. Achieve a VQ, with the appropriate units relevant to the category.

Competent Operator card (Blue)



1. Complete a Plant Operations NVQ.
2. Pass the necessary health and safety awareness test, as determined by the Construction Industry Training Board.
3. Pass the CPCS theory test within two years of Step 2.
4. Pass the CPCS practical test within six months of Step 3.

The blue CPCS card is valid for five years from the date of issue. Holders may prove capability in additional categories within this time frame, which will then be added to the card. However, regardless of how recently some additional categories have been completed, the expiration date remains the same: five years from the date of issue of the card.

Renewing the card is quite straightforward. The card must not have reached the expiry date, and the holder must pass both the CITB health and safety requirements and the CPCS renewal test.

CSCS:

Full CSCS Green Labourer Course:

This price includes the 1-day Health & Safety NPORS course and HS&E Touchscreen test with the card claim after completion.

This card is valid for five years. It is currently not possible to renew a Labourer card. However, you can apply for a new Labourer card when your existing card expires.



Card Requirements

All applicants must pass the **CITB health, safety and environment** test for operatives and hold one of the following:

- 1 Day NPORS Safety awareness course (most common)
- An RQF Level 1/ Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Environment. Please note: the RQF Level 1 Award is a lifetime qualification.
- An SCQF Level 5 REHIS Elementary Health and Safety Certificate.
- The NOCN/CSkills Awards Construction Health and Safety (F/618/0738) unit
- A CSCS approved alternative qualification. Alternative qualifications with an expiry date can only be used once, so you will need to retake these qualifications in the future when you renew your Labourer card.

Type of CSCS Cards

CSCS cards provide the construction industry with a means of identity and proof of competence for individuals working on site. There are nearly 1.8 million cardholders in the UK and most major contractors, homebuilders and local authorities require employees and sub-contractors to hold a valid CSCS card before allowing them access to site. There are a range of CSCS cards available which reflect the variety of occupations in the industry.



Labourer Card (Green)

The green CSCS Construction Labourer Card is available to labourers or workers who carry out basic site skills only; it should not be used as an alternative to the Experienced Worker Card to gain access to site. (The green card was re-launched as the Labourer's card in July 2014).



Apprentice Card (Red)

New entrants who have been registered onto an appropriate training course to achieve the S/NVQ can obtain the red CSCS Trainee Card.



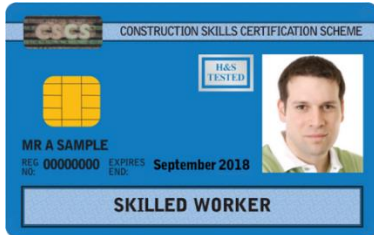
Experienced Worker Card (Red)

Experienced operatives working towards the S/NVQ can obtain the red CSCS Experienced Worker Card. This is valid for one year from the date of issue and cannot be renewed. By the time the card expires, the operative must have achieved the S/NVQ level in order to obtain a Skilled Worker Card.



Trainee Card – Craft, Operative (Red) & Technical, Supervisor, Management (Red)

This card is available if you are a trainee and are registered for an NVQ or SVQ (or if you are registered for or have achieved a Construction Award) but have not yet achieved an NVQ or SVQ. The trainee card is valid for three years and cannot be renewed. Prior to applying for the card applicants are required to have achieved either the CITB Health, Safety and Environment test at the relevant level for their occupation or have attended a 1-day Health and Safety Awareness Course (a copy of the certificate will be required with the application).



Skilled Worker Card (Blue)

Qualified operatives in the Roofing sector should hold the Level 2 _____ S/NVQ and obtain the blue CSCS Skilled Worker Card in the at _____ least one of the roofing disciplines.



Advanced Craft/Supervisory Card (Gold)

This card is available if you have either achieved a Construction Related NVQ or SVQ level 3 or you have completed an approved Level 3 apprenticeship. This card is valid for five years. All applicants must pass the CITB Health, Safety & Environment Test. For Advanced Craft occupations you should take the Operative or the Specialist test depending what your occupation is. For Supervisory occupations you should take the Supervisors test.



Manager Card (Black)

This card is available for manager occupations subject to achievement of a Construction

related NVQ/SVQ Levels 4, 5, (or Construction related QCF Level 6 or 7) in the relevant occupation. This card is valid for five years. All applicants must pass the CITB Managers and Professionals Health, Safety and Environment Test.



Professionally Qualified Person Card (White) & Academically Qualified Person Card (White)

This card is available to competence assessed members of CSCS approved Professional Bodies. This card is valid for five years. All applicants must pass the CITB Managers and Professionals Health, Safety and Environment Test. When you apply for this card you will need to provide your professional body membership number, level of membership (i.e. Institute of Roofing) along with a copy of your professional body membership certificate or card. If you don't have a copy of your membership certificate or membership card you can alternatively provide the name, membership number and contact number of someone of the same level or higher in the same professional body as yours, and who is prepared to recommend you, or supply a letter or email from the professional body confirming that you are a current, competent assessed member.

Information for refresher courses:

To be eligible to sit a street work refresher course your street work card must be within 3 months past the expiry date. (For example, if your card expired in July you have August September and November to complete a refresher course.) Once you have completed the course the certificate from the course is valid for 5 years and is used to claim your new street work card.

Although it is quicker and cheaper to do the refresher course, if you have an expired street work card past the 3-month threshold or you do not have a street work card, Sitting this course will not result in any qualifications SWQR will not issue a refresher card to non-refreshed qualifications.

Mandatory Units:

In order to get a card, you must complete a mandatory unit the mandatory units are: Signing Lighting and Guarding or Location Avoidance.

Order and qualifications:

LA- Location Avoidance of underground services.

Use of CAT & Genny identifying underground services. Understanding HSG47.

02- Signing, Lighting, and guarding.

Safely setting up temporary road works by following the accredited code of practice handbook.

03 - Excavation in the Highway

Safely digging to services. Understanding HSG47 and following the Hauc book.

04 - Reinstatement and compaction of backfill materials.

Identifying different backfill materials as per the specification.

05 - Reinstatement and compaction of sub-base in non-bituminous materials.

How many compactions passes for a given task. Identifying different layer thicknesses.

06- Reinstatement and compaction of cold lay bituminous materials

To break out and reinstate a patch of cold lay using bituminous materials.

07- Reinstatement and compaction of hot lay bituminous materials

Laying tarmac as per specifications, ensuring it is cleanly laid and work is efficiently carried out to specified needs.
